Here is what we have been learning. Please ask your child to elaborate.
Reading: CAFE (C=comprehension; $A=a c c u r a c y ; ~ F=f l u e n c y ; ~ E=e x p a n d i n g ~ v o c a b u l a r y) . ~$
$C$ - We focused this week on summarizing, sequencing events and determining the theme of a story.
A-We focused on variant vowels (oo, u__e, u, ew, ue, ou, ui) as well as the sight words (ever, along, story, won't meant, nothing, during, always, air, draw). We are also working on decoding small words and bigger words as reading.
F- We are having independent reading time each day, working on our stamina as readers. We also have a buddy reading time. We also read fluency packs of poems. This week we focused on pronunciation when reading.
E- We focused on the vocabulary words (agree, challenging, discover, heroes, interest, perform, study, succeed)
Spelling: Please continue to help/encourage your child to study the spelling patterns for each week.
Grade Level Vocabulary Words: We are continuing to review and master our grade level vocabulary words for all subject areas:
Language Arts: text features, fact, opinion, author's purpose, problem, solution, noun, verb, narrative, expository Math: difference, sum, odd, even, fact family, greater than, less than, estimate, data, graph
Science: pollination, property, water source, landforms, observe
Social Studies: community, basic needs, consumer, producer, common good
Writing: We are working on being researchers. Students chose a topic this week and then spent time reading expository books to gather information on 4 different subtopics. Now students will be taking the information they researched, to make an expository book.

Math: We finished Chapter 6: Adding 3 Digit Numbers. After Spring break we will be starting Subtracting 3 Digit Numbers

Science: We have started our first science unit: Matter. We also took some time this week for students to participate in an engineering design activity. Students worked together to use a variety of materials to build and design.

Social/Emotional Learning: Daily, we work on developing and growing in the area of emotions and in relationships with each other. It's important for your child to develop in the following areas:

1. Understanding and managing emotions
2. Setting and achieving positive goals
3. Feeling and showing empathy for others
4. Establishing and maintaining positive relationships
5. Making responsible decisions
